

Foothill College Radio Station To Go On Air

MOUNTAIN VIEW—Foothill College's new FM radio station, KFJC, will go on the air at 8 p.m. Tuesday.

Broadcasting at a fre-

quency of 88.5 megacycles the 30-watt station should have a range of 10 miles.

The student-run station will broadcast a four-night a week program of serious music, jazz, dramatic programs, lectures and special service programs, including sports events.

The station will broadcast Monday through Thursday night, between 8 p.m. and midnight.

Facilities for the station—a studio and control center—are located in the college basement.

Larger quarters are planned for the station in the college's new campus in Los Altos Hills.

A tall antenna mounted on the college's roof will broadcast the station's signals.

Robert Ballou of Palo Alto is student manager of the station. Roy Ruth is program manager and Roger Murray is traffic manager. Additional staff members are being selected.
