## Foothill College Radio Off the Air for a Year

KFJC-FM is closing down operations for at least a year. The will be discontinued to m a ke Foothill College student r u n funds available for construction

of the auditorium at DeAnza College in Cupertino.

The 10-watt station will be losing its manager Ken Clark in July to the U.S. State Department and Radio Television International sponsored team that will go to Ethiopia.

Operating costs at the station would rrmain constant, but the problem the trustees last night could not justify was \$9,000 for the relocation of the transmitter.

Dr. Calvin Flint, district superintendent, said that in a quick survey, he "found only one person who made an attempt to listen to the programs."

"Whether we should continue the radio station comes down to a question as to whether its coverage is broad enough to be justified," he said. "It's loss would not be a major detriment."
