Students Set Up Peninsula Radio Station

A new FM educational station, run by students at Foothill College on the Peninsula, will begin regular broadcasting Tuesday at 8 p. m.

Call letters will be KFJC. It will operate on 30 watts at 88.5 megacycles four nights a week from 8 to 10 p. m. and will be received within a 10 mile radius of the college, at 150 El Camino Real in Mountain View.

Station manager is Robert Ballou, son of Mr. and Mrs. Byron Ballou of 3945 El Cerito Rd., Palo Alto. Ballou's father and a neighbor, Russel Rhoades, built some of the equipment and the younger Ballou spearheaded the project.

Other student station officials will be Roy Ruth and Roger Murray. KFJC is part of the mass communications division of the junior college, of which Ervin L. Harlacher is chairman. Fred Critchfield, radio instructor, is station advisor.

Programs will consist of good music, lectures, jazz and drama.
