

Foothill College Opening Radio Station October 15

Foothill College's 10-watt radio station, KFJC, is scheduled to go on the air Oct. 15, Ervin L. Harlacher, director of public information, reported this morning.

The station will be powerful enough to be picked up on radios from San Mateo to San Jose.

Harlacher says that a 25-foot antenna has just been hoisted atop the main college building.

The station will operate just two hours per night at first, but the college division of mass communications, of which Harlacher is chairman,

hopes to increase this before the school year ends. There will be no daytime broadcasting.

Programming will consist primarily of classical music with some educational programs, drama and news occasionally presented.

Listeners will hear no commercials. The station is being financed entirely by the Foothill Junior College District.
