

Foothill FM Station Open Tomorrow

A new educational FM radio station operated by Foothill College in Mountain View goes on the air tomorrow night at 8 o'clock.

College officials had hoped to have "KFJC," the new radio station, on the airways a week earlier, but late arrival of an approval from the Federal Communications Commission caused the week delay.

Tomorrow night's shows will be devoted to a dedication of the station and a preview of events to come of KFJC, according to student station manager Bob Ballou.

The station will normally operate between 8 p.m. and 1 p.m., Monday through Thursday from 88.5 megacycles of the dial.

KFJC's transmitter is located on the temporary college campus in the old highway school building on Calderon ave. at El Camino Real, in Mountain View.

Highlights of the opening night of broadcasting will be an opening address by Dr. Calvin C. Flint, president of Foothill College.

Following welcoming speeches, Station Manager Ballou will introduce his staff to the listening audience. Members of the staff are Roy Ruth, program manager; Roger Murray, traffic manager, and John DeLamater, Susan Hochman, Fred Kulick, Jacqueline Nicholas and Bruce Wentler, announcers.
