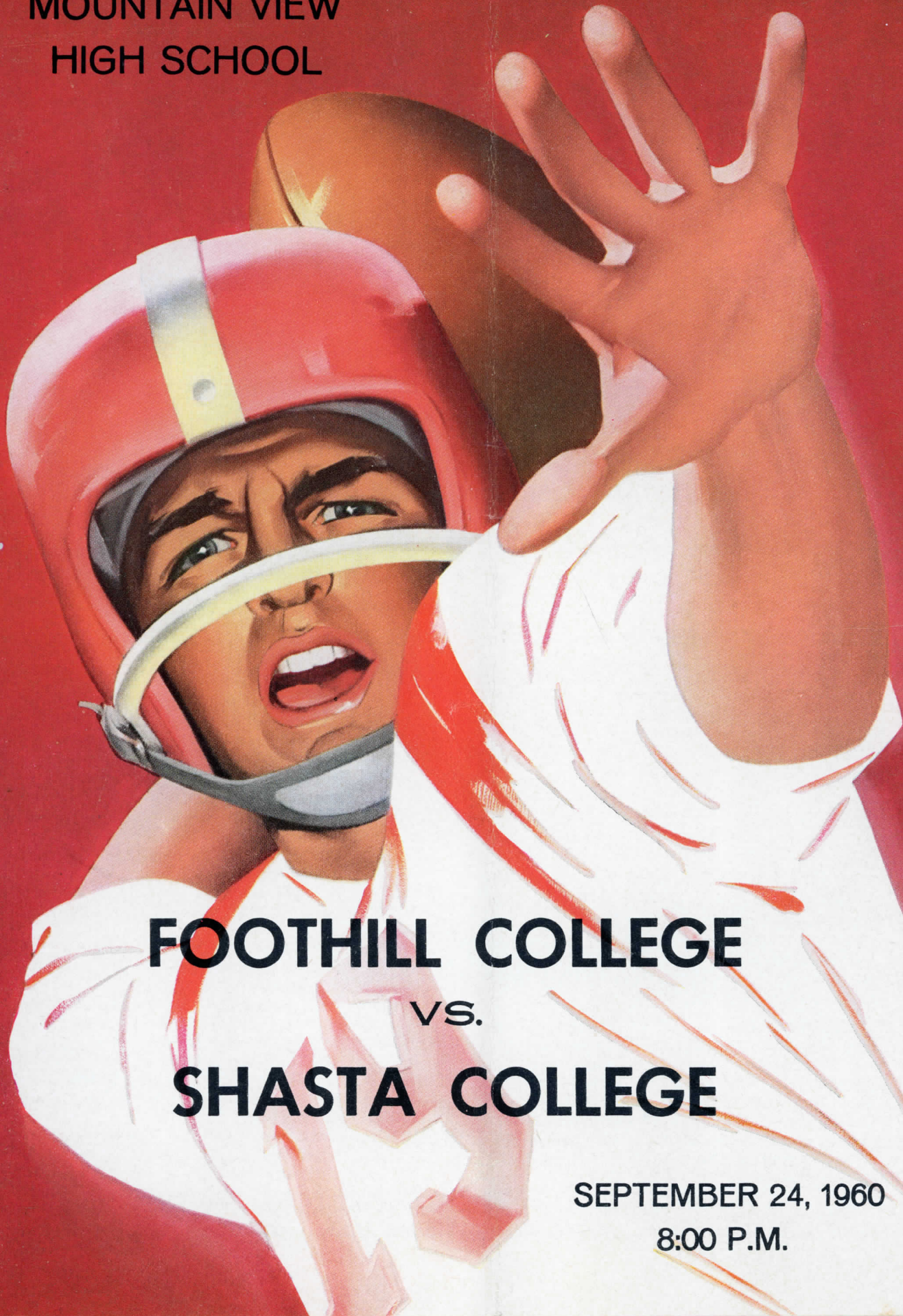

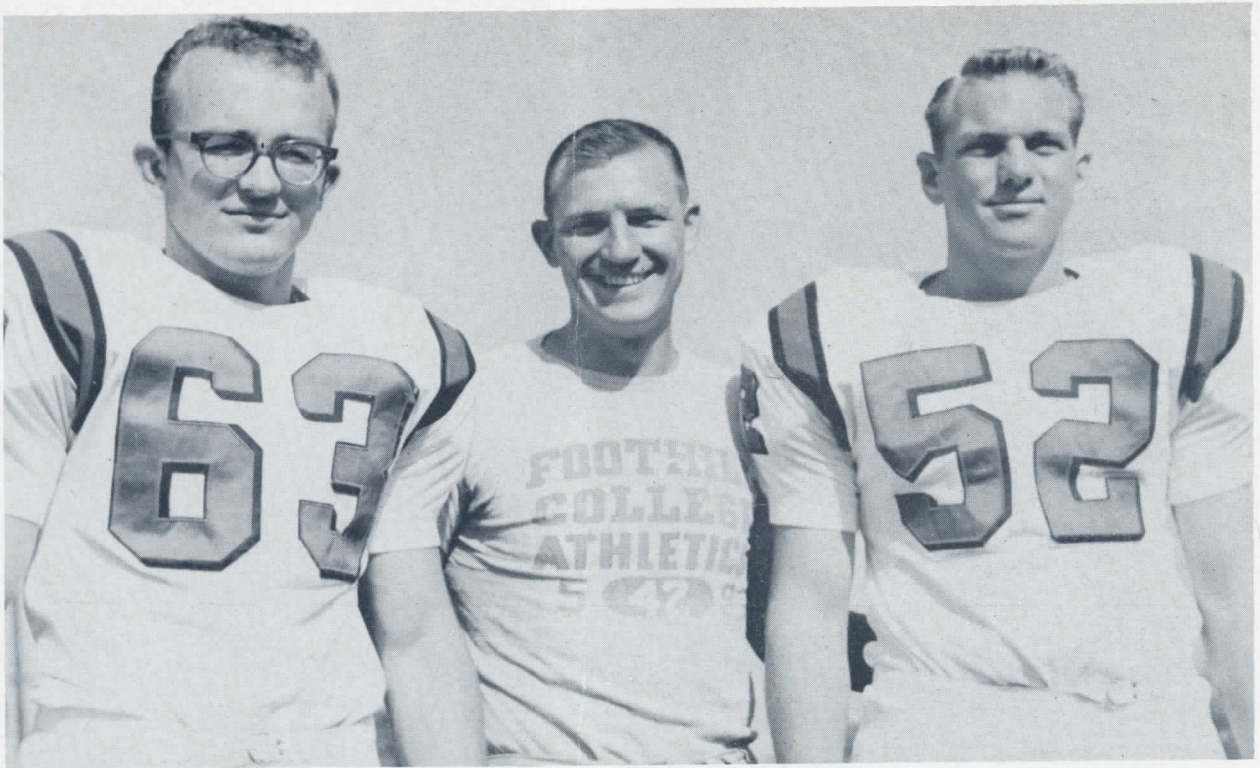

Owl's Nest

TONIGHT'S CO-CAPTAINS—Leading Foothill's Owls into tonight's season opener against Shasta College are guard Adam Jaworski, left, and tackle Dick Dalke, shown with head coach Bill Abbey. Two of the mere handful of lettermen who form the nucleus of the 1960 squad, these two are tabbed for starting honors.

The Football College Owls open their second season on the gridiron tonight when they meet the Knights from Shasta College. The inexperienced Owls of last season had a successful campaign with an overall 5-4 record. In conference play they compiled a 2-4 record and a fifth place standing in the Coast Conference.

Shasta College had a 4-5 record for the year and placed third in the Golden Valley Conference. The Foothill was the first to hand the Knights a loss last season with a 27-20 victory at Redding.

The Owls have seven lettermen returning from their first year of competition: end Bob Marshall, tackle Dick Dalke, guards Adam Jaworski and Bill Furuoka, center Jim Noon and halfbacks Paul Cook and John Finegold.

Jaworski was one of the better defensive men last season and was one of the All Conference second team. At 175 pounds, he has added a little heft this year and should be of great help to the Owls. Dalke, who gained conference honorable mention recognition last season, was well deserving of the award and is as tough as they come in his tackle slot.

Two eye-catching halfbacks this year are Paul Cook and Frank Aquino. Cook,

at 155 pounds, is faster and stronger than last season. His running mate, Aquino, adds most of the speed to the Owl backfield and at 140 pounds is not only fast but is shifty enough to stop on a dime. The former Mountain View High School star should really give the fans their money's worth in his first year at Foothill. Another back to watch is Jarod Middleton, 185-pound fullback, who played his prep ball at Samuel Ayer High School in Milpitas where he was voted the most valuable player.

The quarterback spot is still up for grabs, with the departure of All Conference Bill Munson. Terry Ogden, the ex-Marine from Los Gatos, has a slight edge at this writing but is being pressed by Wayman Crowder of Palo Alto who played high school ball at North Dallas, Texas. Ogden, a 175-opunder, gained all-league and most valuable back honors at Camp Pendleton in 1959.

The overall picture for the Owls this season looks promising, despite the lack of experienced hold-overs. With all-out effort on the part of each individual, they ought to do a fine job and if I know Coach Bill Abbey, he'll see to it that they do.

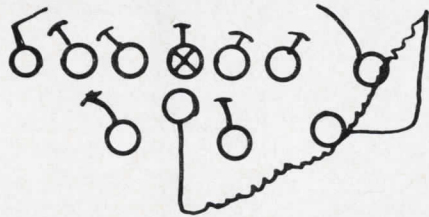
Footsie, the Foothill College Owl, appears to be home to stay this year after last year's shenanigans.

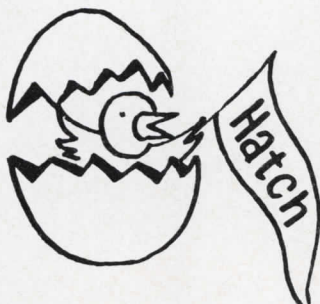
