New School Radio on Air This Fall

Three students at Foothill College at Mountain View are impatiently watching the hours tick by for the day next month when the school's new FM educational radio sta-

tion equipment tests start. The students are Bob Ballou, Dick Thiesse and Bob Johnson who are responsible for getting the college administration to give the green

light to FM radio station KFJC (88.5 megacycles), which will begin broadcasts next fall.

The trio thought it would be a good idea for the college

to have an FM news bureau station. Last October they prepared and submitted an estimated budget for such a project. The preliminary budget was approved by college authorities, who called for a final draft for the first year costs.

Ballou was appointed sta-

tion manager and the project was placed under supervision of Ervin L. Harlacher, chairman of the communications division. Subsequently the school board approved an outlay of \$4,500 for the station. The application was approved by the Federal Communications Commission recently.
